3 Wrinkles might get more attention, but straightening your teeth is one of the most effective anti-ageing treatments. Braces promise lifelong results, but require serious time commitment. Enter the new '6 month smile' at The Welbeck Clinic (thewelbeckclinic.co.uk). From £1,750, it aligns teeth more quickly because it doesn't attempt to shift the bite. For a more established option, try lingual braces, where brackets are fixed inside the teeth (from £3,800, londonlingualbraces.com). Or, Invisalign braces are almost invisible moulds fitted to your teeth (from £2,500; londonsmiling.com).
